

## ***This I Know* by Anthony P. Carter – Talking Points and Sample Questions**

### Talking points:

- The book follows Anthony P. Carter's journey from the South Bronx to leadership roles in Fortune 100 companies with faith as a constant .
- Carter writes about what it means to be a Black Catholic navigating corporate America and the broader culture.
- Carter is Jesuit educated and he draws on Ignatian values such as discernment, reflection, and service.
- He frames leadership as service, rather than status .
- He reflects on how faith sustains hope amid adversity and change.
- The foreword by Denzel Washington, Carter's lifelong friend, reflects a shared history and shared values of faith, integrity, and responsibility (not celebrity).
- The book invites readers to reflect on how faith shapes who they are, how they lead, and how they love.
- The book will be released by Loyola Press on February 10, 2026, and will be available on their website and from all major booksellers.

### Sample interview questions:

What inspired you to write *This I Know*?

In what ways does *This I Know* reflect your Jesuit formation and the values it instilled in you?

Your story includes moments of challenge around race, identity, and belonging. How did your faith sustain you through those seasons?

How do you hope readers, especially those who may feel distant from the Church, will engage with this book?

What do you hope Catholics take with them after reading *This I Know*?

This book speaks honestly about leadership and responsibility. How do you see faith shaping leadership today, both inside and outside the Church?

How does *This I Know* invite readers to see God present in their everyday lives?

In a time when many people feel weary or discouraged, what do you hope this book offers?
