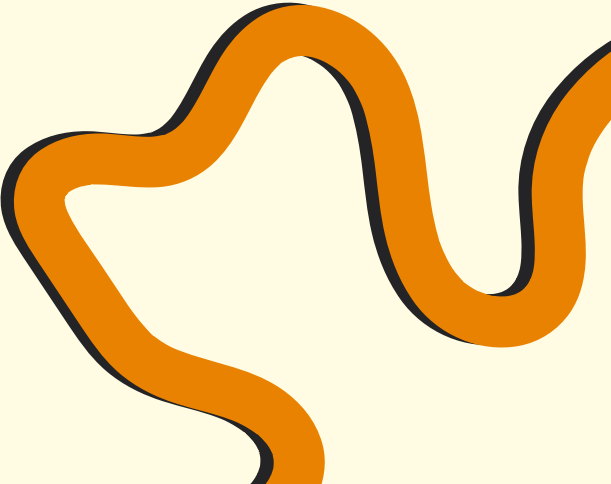
Legacy of Excellence in Equestrian Sport

An Exceptional Adjustment for an Exceptional Season

The Nations Cup presented by STX Finance will not take place during the 2026 Brussels Stephex Masters.

This one-year adjustment was made following careful consideration of an exceptional international calendar. With the FEI Jumping World Championship in Aachen taking place only days before Brussels, riders, owners and their teams face particularly demanding decisions regarding the management and planning of their top horses.

By adapting the programme, the Brussels Stephex Masters aims to give leading riders greater flexibility while reducing the pressure on their horses and maintaining an exceptional international field throughout the week.

The Nations Cup remains an important part of the event's identity, with this adjustment applying specifically to the 2026 edition.

Brussels Derby Challenge

A completely new sporting spectacle is coming to the Home of Champions. On Saturday 29 August at 1:30 PM, the inaugural Brussels Derby Challenge will make full use of the exceptional grass arenas at Stephex Stables. Taking place across the Sablon Arena and Place de l'Atomium, the course will combine traditional fences with natural obstacles including banks, hedges and ditches.

Rarely seen on today's international calendar, the derby offers a completely different test of trust, technique and courage, and one of the most spectacular experiences for spectators.

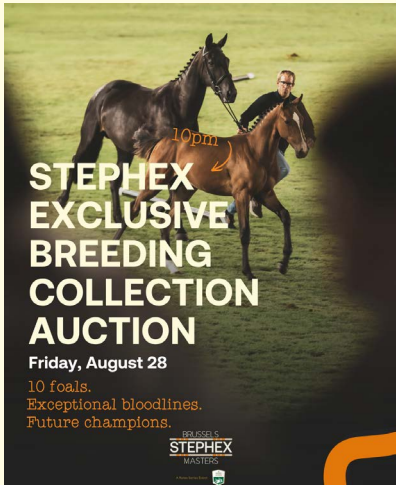
Thursday 27 August

Thursday marks the arrival of the world's best riders as the CSI5* competition gets underway. The atmosphere rises another level as elite sport takes centre stage. At 8:30 PM, don't miss the first qualifying class for the Rolex Grand Prix presented by Audi: a CSI5* 1.50m Table A against the clock, setting the tone for an exciting weekend of top-level sport.

Friday 28 August



Friday evening begins with top-level sport. At 8:00 PM, the world’s best riders will compete in the second qualifying class for the Rolex Grand Prix presented by Audi, a CSI5* 1.50m Table A against the clock, with one horse per rider. At 10:00 PM, a different kind of excitement takes over with the Stephex Exclusive Breeding Collection Auction. An exclusive selection of ten exceptional foals, carefully chosen for their pedigree, quality and future potential, will be presented to an international audience during a live and online auction. Descending from some of the most accomplished mares and stallions in international show jumping, the collection offers buyers the opportunity to invest in the next generation of the sport. Set within the unique atmosphere of the Brussels Stephex Masters, the auction has become one of the most anticipated moments of the week, bringing together breeding, sport and the search for tomorrow’s champions.

Saturday 29 August



Saturday is packed with sport from morning to night, starting with the CSI1* Prestige League Grand Prix, followed by the CSI2* Super Cup Grand Prix. At 1:30 PM, one of the major new highlights of 2026 takes centre stage. The brand-new Brussels Derby Challenge promises spectacular sport and a unique test unlike anything else on the programme, combining traditional fences with natural obstacles across the grass arenas. The action continues into the evening with the CSI5* Audi at 9:00 PM, a 1.50m class with jump-off and €70,000 in prize money, including an Audi.

Sunday 30 August

Sunday begins with another major sporting moment as the Top Series CSI3* Grand Prix takes centre stage, with riders competing over a 1.50m course with jump-off.

The week will reach its pinnacle on Sunday afternoon, 2:30 PM with the Rolex Grand Prix presented by Audi, the sporting highlight of the Brussels Stephex Masters. The world’s best horse-and-rider combinations will take on a demanding 1.60m course over two rounds, where precision, experience and consistency will be decisive in the battle for one of the week’s most prestigious victories.

In 2025, Nina Mallevaey and Dynastie de Beaufour delivered an unforgettable performance to claim the title. One year later, Mallevaey returns to Brussels as defending champion, ready to face another exceptional international field.

THE CHAMPION RETURNS

Interview with Nina Mallevaey

After her unforgettable victory with Dynastie de Beaufour in the 2025 Rolex Grand Prix presented by Audi, Nina Mallevaey returns to the Brussels Stephex Masters as defending champion. One year on, she looks back on a career-defining moment and shares her thoughts ahead of her return to the Home of Champions.

You return to Brussels this year as the defending Rolex Grand Prix champion. How does it feel to come back to a place where you experienced such an important victory?

It feels very special. Brussels will always be an important show for me because of what happened last year. It was one of the biggest wins of my career so far and an incredible moment to share with Dynastie and our whole team. Coming back brings back so many great memories and, of course, makes me even more excited to compete there again.

What do you remember most vividly from your Rolex Grand Prix presented by Audi win last year?

Probably the feeling when I realised we had won. Everything happens so quickly that you don't really have time to think about what it could mean. Then suddenly it was done, and seeing my dad, our team, the Rein family and everyone around us so happy made it even more special. Those are the moments we work for every day.

When you entered the arena for the second round, did you feel that victory was possible?

I knew Dynastie was in good form and capable of winning a Grand Prix like this. I was 100% motivated when I entered the arena. We had a real chance, and I tried to give everything.

Has that victory changed anything for you, either in your career or in the way you approach major Grand Prix classes today?

I think every big experience helps you grow as a rider. Winning a Grand Prix like Brussels gives you confidence because you know that you and your horse are capable of performing at that level. But at the same time, our sport keeps you very humble. Every week is different, every course is different and nothing is ever guaranteed. I try to keep the same approach: work hard, listen to my horses and keep improving.

What makes the Brussels Stephex Masters different from other international events from a rider's perspective?

Everything is done at a very high level and the atmosphere is really special. The arena, the crowd, the quality of the sport and all the details around the event make it a show that, as a rider, you really look forward to competing at. I also remember how the whole crowd stayed for the prize-giving ceremony last year. That made the victory even more special.

Coming back as defending champion, do you feel more pressure or even more motivation?

Probably more motivation than pressure!

What would it mean to win the Rolex Grand Prix presented by Audi for a second consecutive year?

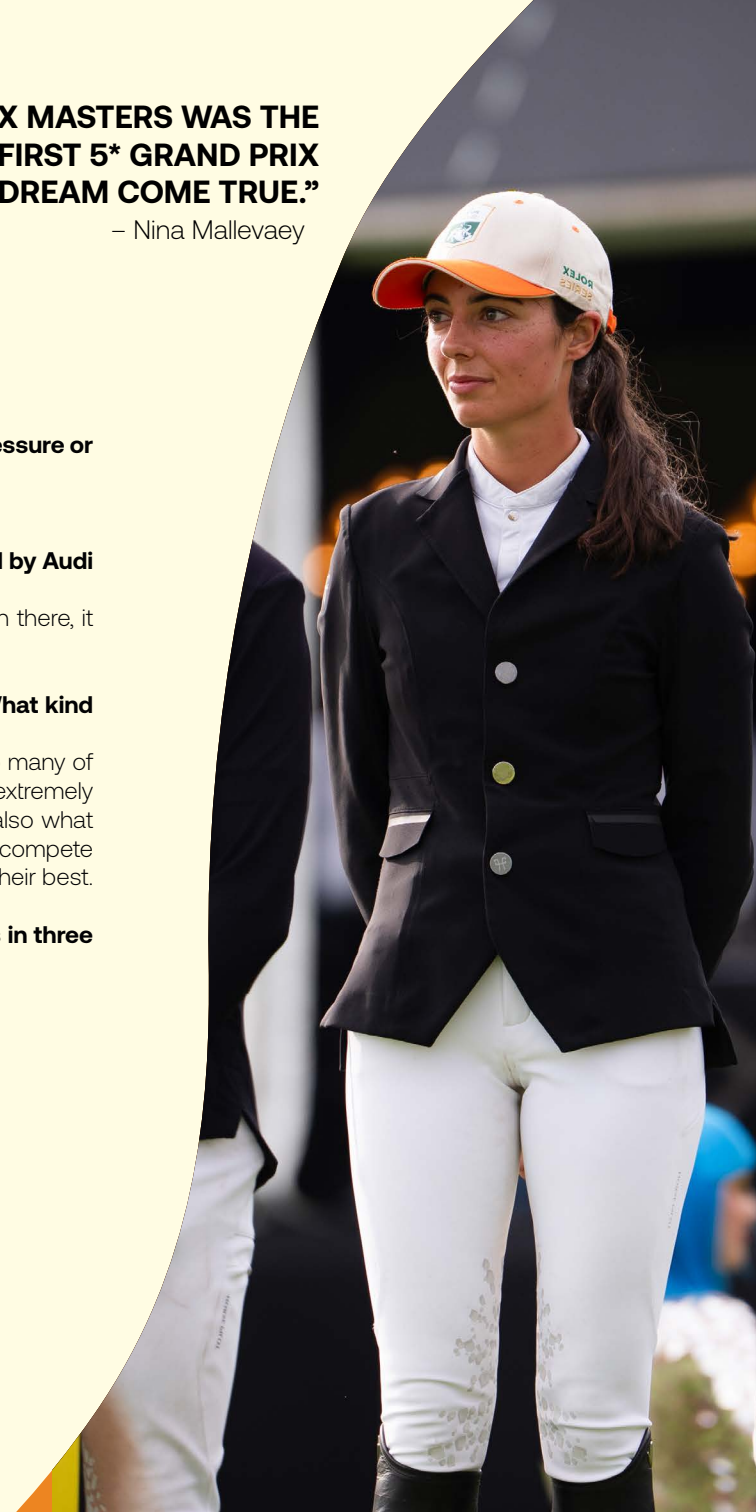
It would be incredible! Now that I know what it feels like to win there, it makes me want to experience that feeling again even more.

19 riders from the World Top 35 are expected this year. What kind of competition are you expecting?

It's going to be a very competitive Grand Prix, for sure. With so many of the world's best riders and horses, you know the level will be extremely high and there will be very little room for mistakes. But that's also what makes these Grand Prix classes so exciting. You want to compete against the best in the world, and it pushes everyone to be at their best.

Finally, if you could describe your 2025 victory in Brussels in three words, what would they be?

Unforgettable. Emotional. Teamwork.

Every Rolex Grand Prix victory leaves its mark on the history of the Brussels Stephex Masters.

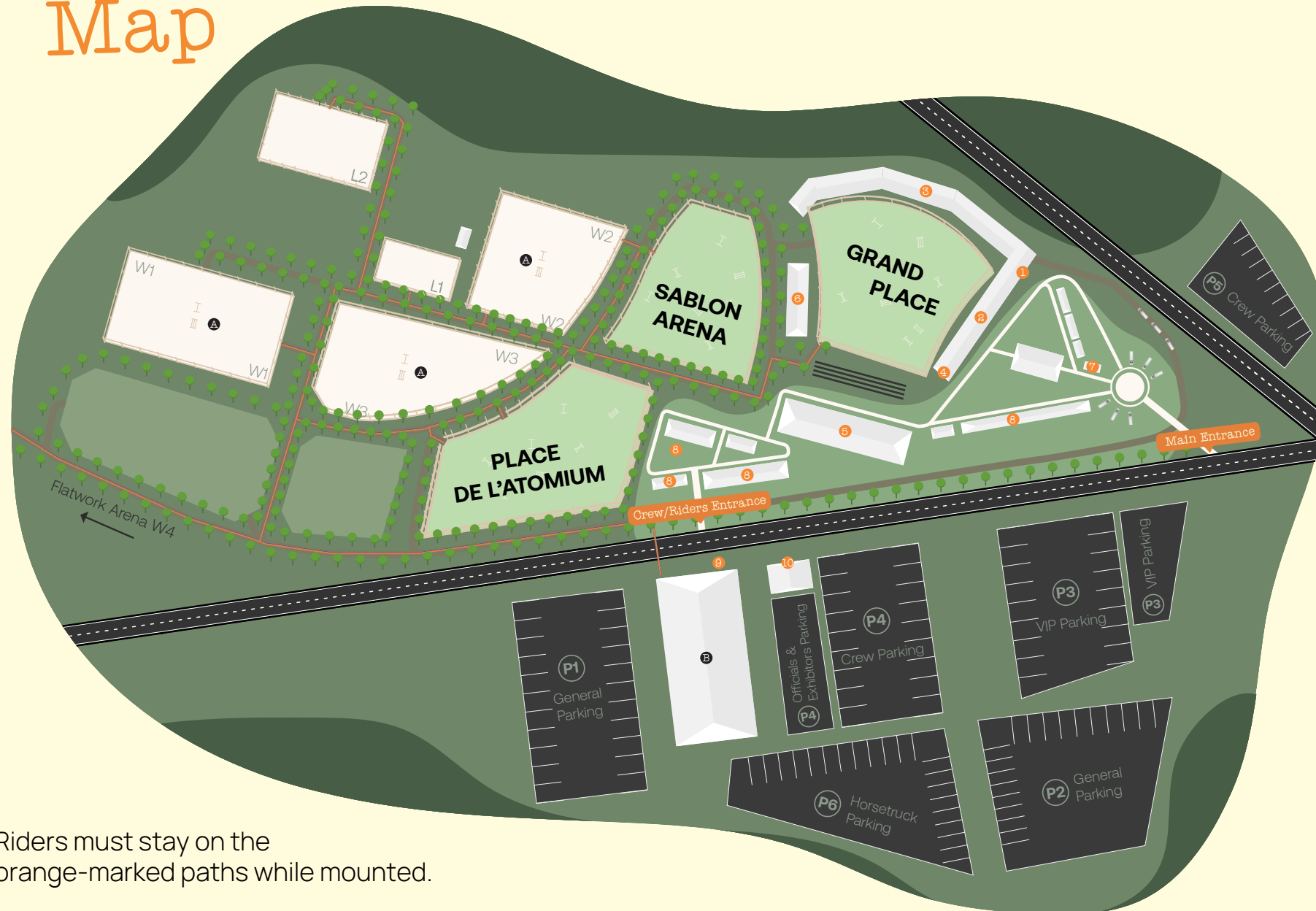

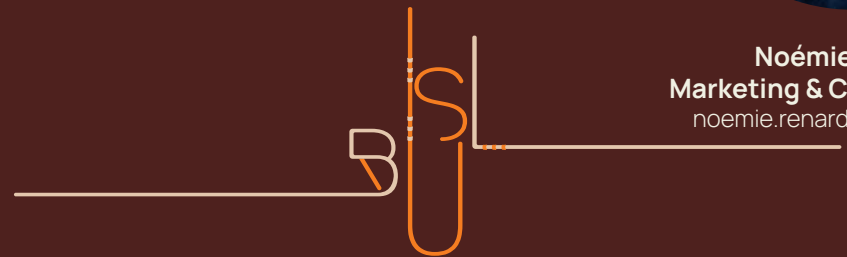
