Timeline of Events

- **September 21st, 2026:** International Day of Peace. Host a local exhibit of project artwork in your school or community. Upload photos of your exhibits to Instagram at any time using [#PlanetEarthLoveProject](#) and tag [@29Pieces](#).
- **February 14, 2027:** Submissions will be considered for [The Planet Earth Love Project](#) Art Competition. You must upload images to Instagram. Tag [@29Pieces](#) and use the hashtag [#PlanetEarthLoveProject](#) to be considered. Winners will receive prize money for their submissions.
- **April 22, 2027:** Earth Day. Winners will be announced.
